MEDIA AND SIZE REQUIREMENTS: Photography/Digital Media or Original Art: paintings, drawings, mixed media, collage, graphics, prints or fiber art. No reproductions. Must be framed. We will not accept pieces in multiple parts. **Art** should not project more than 3" from the wall. **ALL WORK MUST BE WIRED TO BE HUNG AND SHOULD BE NO LARGER THAN 28" X 36" INCLUDING FRAME. NO SAW-TOOTH HANGERS. NO EASEL BACKS.**

We regret that we cannot accept any works not complying with the above rules.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE - All local Artists and photographers whose work meets our requirements.

How to submit your art - Entries will be accepted from Wednesday Feb 1st - Sunday, Feb 12th. All entries must be accompanied by a fully completed entry form.

NOTE: THIS IS A JURIED ART SHOW AND SPACE IS LIMITED. NOT ALL WORK WILL BE SELECTED.
