The 2023 Holiday Show is fast approaching. The show will be held at the William Sanford Library in Colonie, NY during the month of December 2023. Each CAL member will be able to submit **one (1)** piece of artwork for the Holiday Show (\$10.00 fee to enter) and up to **two (2)** Small Works for sale. The show will include many cash awards. Winners will be announced at the show reception.

#### You must be a current member to participate. **Important Dates:**

Thursday, November 30, 1:00 to 4:00 pm: Intake

Friday, December 1, 10:00 to 11:30 am: Intake

11:30 am to 3:30 pm: Hanging (Including small works)

3:30 pm to 5:30 pm **Judging** 

Sunday, December 3, 2:00 to 4:00 pm: **Reception** 

Friday, December 29, 1:00 to 5:00 pm: Pick-up Artwork

#### **General Rules for Entry**

Enter one (1) original painting/photograph completed within the last 3 years and not shown in a previous CAL exhibition.

**Entry Fee: \$10.00 for one piece** 

**Size limit: 36" X 36"** including the frame's outside dimensions.

Painting must be dry, sturdily framed, wired, and ready to hang. Gallery wrapped paintings on canvas must have all edges painted to be accepted. Watercolor, pastels, drawings, etc. must be under glass or acrylic. No prints or art based on greeting cards, calendar art, magazine photos, etc.

## **Exhibit Categories**

We have made changes to our categories. There will no longer be a Judge's Circle category and, instead of only one award for Emerging Artist, we will have 1st, 2nd, 3rd place awards and one Honorable Mention in this category. Other categories remain the same.

**Paint on Canvas** including oil, acrylics, and water media (any medium used in an aqueous manner)

Paint on Paper including oil, acrylics, and water media

#### **Pastel**

**Other** (including - drawings (pen/ink, charcoal, pencil/graphite, colored pencil, markers), collage, mixed media (2 or more media), encaustic, photography, digital photography (all forms of digital including manipulated), and traditional printmaking (limited edition of 10, hand- pulled original prints only).

**Emerging Artist:** Anyone who has never received any award from CAL or any other art organization for work in any medium submitted for any show or exhibit. Any award means best in show first, second or third prize or honorable mention or any other competitive recognition. Check the emerging artist box category on the application.

**Small Works Sale:** We will be filling the entrance hall to the library gallery with small works for immediate sale. These sale items are in addition to your one entry to the show and will not be judged. There is no fee to enter small artworks.

**Size limit:** 12" x 12" including the frame's outside dimensions.

**Maximum price:** \$75.

#### Two (2) small works per artist

Giclee and prints are acceptable but must be marked as such. Label your piece with name, telephone number and price using the form below. Buyers will contact you directly. You may replace any painting you sell. Your replacement must be the same price and size as the piece sold. New pieces will use the number assigned the original piece entered.

She resides in Delmar, NY and teaches oil, watercolor and pastel painting classes throughout the capital district.

Robert has been commissioned to paint the official portrait of a senior Federal District Court Judge.

Everyone is invited to "A 50-year Career of Painting........So Far: **Bob Blackmon** at the East Greenbush Library." This solo show of approximately 50 oil and acrylic works will include Bob's trademark Baroque-style still lifes, plus landscapes, seascapes, spacescapes, sunrises, and sunsets. Not surprisingly, many of the paintings include an Ireland theme.

The library is located at 10 Community Way, East Greenbush, New York, just off Route 155. The show runs November 1 to 30. The opening reception is Sunday, November 5, 2 to 4 pm. Please plan to join us; the treats will be excellent, and the art will be a treat as well.

This past May, Albany celebrated the 75th anniversary of the Tulip Festival. The Festival started when Queen Wilhelmina of the Netherlands sent 2,000 tulips to Albany in thanks for post WWII aid sent by Albany citizens to Nijmegan. The aid was organized by General Gavin, who liberated Nijmegen, a city in the Netherlands near the border of Germany, from the Germans in September 1944. General Gavin's daughter and the current mayor of Nijmegen attended the 75th anniversary celebrations in Albany. What a surprise to **Mary Gaillard** when a friend of hers bought her watercolor painting of the tulip gardens in Washington Park and sent it to her friend, the daughter of General Gavin, who then sent a copy to the mayor of Nijmegen!
